Dear General Counsel:

The ABA Section of Administrative Law and Regulatory Practice is examining the procedures pertaining to the discipline of private sector attorneys appearing before federal agencies. Although the procedures pertaining to discipline of federal sector employees who serve as federal attorneys are generally found in Title 5 of the Code of Federal Regulations, there is no similar source for reviewing procedures pertaining to private sector attorneys. Our Section's Committee on Ethics and Professional Responsibility is compiling the procedures applicable in various agencies to study and to prepare a report and recommendations on best practices.

Accordingly, we would greatly appreciate obtaining copies of any policies, procedures, regulations, rules, or guidelines that your agency has which relate to procedures pertaining to the discipline of private sector attorneys.
