The ICN conference, hosted by Russia's competition authority, the Federal Antimonopoly Service, was held on May 30 through June 1, 2007. More than 350 delegates and competition experts participated, representing more than 80 antitrust agencies, international organizations, and the legal, business, consumer, and academic communities. The conference focused on the recent work of its four working groups on Mergers, Unilateral Conduct, Cartels, and Competition Policy Implementation, including: prospects for convergence on substantive merger review issues; objectives of competition laws on unilateral conduct and definition and assessment of market power/dominance; international cooperation in cartel investigations and case selection and prioritization.
