Some of her other notable settlements include: *In re Brand Name Drug Litigation*, \$65 million settlement; and *In re Warfarin Sodium Antitrust Litigation*, \$44.5 million settlement. Ms. Hart co-authored "Antitrust Protections Expanded in New York", *New York Law Journal*, June 22, 1999. In addition, she is regularly called upon to lecture on cutting-edge issues in her field and has appeared before the Council of Institutional Investors, The Federalist Society, the New York Bar Association, The Institute for Law and Economic Policy, the Public Funds Forum and the Practicing Law Institute.

Ms. Hart is a graduate of Vanderbilt University (B.A. 1982), the University of North Carolina (M.A. 1987), and the Fordham University School of Law (J.D. 1992), where she was a member of the Law Review and on the Dean's List.
