**Practice Description** Roxane C. Busey, a partner in the Chicago office of Baker & McKenzie, is a nationally recognized antitrust attorney. She served as Chair of the ABA Section of Antitrust Law in 2001-02. She currently serves as Chair of the Section's Task Force on the Antitrust Modernization Commission. She also served on the Section's Special Task Forces on Competition Policy to the Clinton Transition Team and to the Bush Transition Team.

Ms. Busey's practice includes both antitrust counseling and litigation. She has practiced before the Federal Trade Commission, the Department of Justice, and various state antitrust enforcement agencies. Ms. Busey recently served as one of the lead counsel defending the National Resident Matching Program in *Jung v. AAMC*, an antitrust class action lawsuit alleging a wage fixing conspiracy among many of the nation's leading teaching hospitals.

A significant portion of Ms. Busey's practice relates to mergers, joint ventures and strategic alliances. She has obtained merger clearance from the FTC or the DOJ for transactions in consumer products, office equipment, insurance, telecommunications, natural gas, health care, ATM and tobacco industries. She also works in conjunction with the firm's global competition network of over 240 competition lawyers to provide multijurisdictional merger control and other antitrust advice.

Ms. Busey is both a counselor and strategist on antitrust compliance issues in a variety of industries. She has substantial experience in the health care and insurance industries and in representing trade and professional organizations. She recently participated in a standard setting investigation involving issues of the disclosure of intellectual property.

**Professional Affiliations** Ms. Busey has been active in the leadership of the ABA Antitrust Section for the past twenty years. Before becoming Section Chair, she served in several officer positions, on the Section's Council, as chair of and then liaison to the Health Care Committee, and as liaison to the Insurance Committee. She has chaired two of the Section's Task Forces on Health Care and has testified before the FTC on Joint Ventures; Efficiencies and Global Competition; Intellectual Property; and Health Care.

Ms. Busey is also a past Chair of both the Antitrust Section of the Chicago Bar Association and the Illinois State Bar Association's Antitrust Council. She has also served as Chair of the Health Care Committee of the American Health Lawyers Association.

**Publications, Presentations and Articles.** Ms. Busey is a frequent lecturer and author on antitrust issues. Most recently, she spoke on *Antitrust Modernization: Exclusionary Conduct* at the Antitrust Section's program in Philadelphia. She is co-chair of the Practicing Lawyers Institute's antitrust program in Chicago where she regularly speaks on *Relationships Among Competitors*. She has also spoken on *Antitrust Counseling* for the Antitrust Section's biannual Master's Program.
