Lesley Fair is a Senior Attorney with the Federal Trade Commission's Bureau of Consumer Protection, where she has represented the FTC in numerous investigations of false advertising. A recipient of the Paul Rand Dixon Award for Law Enforcement and the Commission's Award for Outstanding Scholarship, she now specializes in business education and compliance.

Ms. Fair is a Vice-Chair of the Consumer Protection Committee of the American Bar Association's Section of Antitrust Law and served as co-editor-in-chief of the ABA's *Consumer Protection Update*. On the faculty of the Catholic University Law School since 1984, Ms. Fair holds the title of Distinguished Lecturer and was recently named Outstanding Adjunct Professor by the Student Bar Association. She also has served as a Hearst Foundation Visiting Professional at the University of North Carolina School of Journalism and Mass Communication.

Ms. Fair was born in Frankfurt, Germany and attended T.C. Williams High School in Alexandria, Virginia, during the years depicted in the movie *Remember the Titans*. She graduated from the University of Notre Dame and received a J.D. from the University of Texas School of Law. She was law clerk to United States District Judge Fred Shannon of the Western District of Texas and served as staff counsel to the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit in New Orleans. Before coming to the FTC, Ms. Fair practiced criminal law and appeared before the Supreme Court of the United States in Murray v. Carrier.
