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Professor First's most recent scholarly work has focused on various aspects of the *Microsoft* litigation, and includes "*Microsoft* and the Evolution of the Intellectual Property Concept," 2006 Wisc. L. Rev. 1369, and "Re-framing Windows: The Durable Meaning of the *Microsoft* Antitrust Litigation," 2006 Utah L. Rev. 641 (with Andrew Gavil). He and Professor Andrew Gavil are currently working on a book titled "Microsoft and the Globalization of Competition Policy: A Study in Antitrust Institutions," to be published by MIT Press.

Professor First is an Associate Editor of Antitrust Magazine, a member of the Executive Committee of the Antitrust Section of the New York State Bar Association, and a member of the Advisory Board of the American Antitrust Institute. He was also counsel to the Petitioner in *Anza v. Ideal Steel Supply Corp.*, 126 S. Ct. 1991 (2006).
