

## BIOGRAPHY

**Henry C. Su** is a partner in the law firm of Howrey LLP, where he specializes in litigation, alternative dispute resolution and strategic counseling of disputes involving intellectual property and antitrust claims. Based in Silicon Valley and San Francisco, a major gateway to the Pacific Rim, Mr. Su handles legal matters primarily for high technology companies, both domestic and foreign.

Before moving to California, Mr. Su practiced for a number of years in Virginia. There he accumulated substantial experience in shepherding cases through the Eastern District of Virginia, which has historical notoriety as a “rocket docket,” so named because of the relatively short period of time for cases to progress from filing to trial. Indeed, his experience with the Eastern District of Virginia extends not only to civil cases but to criminal cases as well, through appointments under the Criminal Justice Act, which he regularly accepted for over eight years and tried a number to a jury.

Mr. Su is a member of the bars of the State of California, the District of Columbia and the Commonwealth of Virginia, as well as a registered patent attorney with the United States Patent and Trademark Office. He has a B.S. degree in biology from Yale University, where he graduated *cum laude*, and a J.D. degree from the University of Virginia School of Law, where he was a recipient of the John M. Olin Prize in Law and Economics.
