How to Enter:

- 1.) Publish an article in a law review or legal journal that is sponsored by an ABA-accredited law school. Eligible articles must be written by a currently-enrolled or graduating student and published between **January 1, 2008 and March 1, 2009**.
- 2.) Each law review or legal journal's Editor-in-Chief may nominate one paper for the award.
 - Submit eligible papers in their published form. **Eligible papers** include published notes, comments and article and should generally be 20-30 pages in length, with footnotes. In no event may papers exceed 50 pages, with footnotes.
 - **Eligible papers** may address any topic of general interest to the antitrust law community, including topics relating to civil and criminal antitrust law, competition policy, consumer protection and international competition law.
 - Work that is **not eligible** includes joint papers and unpublished work, including

work that was prepared for a class, seminar, or independent study.

- 3.) Go to the Antitrust Section on the ABA website and click on the "Young Lawyers and Law Students" section and download an Entry Form. Mail three copies of the paper, along with a completed Entry Form, by January 30, 2009 to:
