

## **Searchable Antitrust Library – SAL**

SAL is a search tool to help you find Antitrust Section Material of interest.

### **WHICH SECTION MATERIALS ARE IN IT?**

Antitrust Law Journal	(2001 → )
Antitrust Magazine	(2001 → )
Antitrust Source	(2001 → )
Committee Newsletter	(2001 → )
Comments, Reports and Amicus Briefs	(all)
Publication Descriptions & Purchase Links	(1996 → )

### **DOES SAL PERFORM A FULL TEXT SEARCH?**

Only if you use the “search” options page. The quick search defaults to searching the title only. This is the search site on the home page.

### **WILL SAL JUMP TO THE RELEVANT TEXT CONTAINING THE SEARCH TERM?**

No, SAL will identify the materials, which may then be printed or read on-line.

### **IN THE “SEARCH” FUNCTION AT THE TOP OF EVERY PAGE PART OF SAL?**

No, this searches parts of the ABA – not the Antitrust Section – website. It is not specific to the Antitrust Section and should not be confused with SAL.

### **CAN SEARCHES BE MADE BY AUTHOR, DATE, PUBLICATION OR COMMITTEE?**

Yes, go the “search option” or “search screen” page.

### **CAN SEARCHES BE MADE BY ANTITRUST TOPIC**

Yes. Topics are organized by Antitrust Law Developments chapters. Go to the “search options” or “search screen” page.

### **IS SAL AVAILABLE TO NON-SECTION MEMBERS?**

Yes, but Section membership is required to open or print some of the items found in a search. For member-only-content, you must first log in with your user ID and password.

**IS THE TEXT OF ALD IN SAL?**

No, for ALD, like other Section publications available for purchase, the description of the publication is in SAL, and a SAL search will link you to the relevant part of the ABA bookstore catalog for purchase.

**ARE ARCHIVED DISCUSSION LIST MATERIALS SEARCHABLE THROUGH SAL?**

No. To search the archives of AT-Conversation, go to the AT-Conversation page, which has its own search engine.
