Patricia F. Bak is an attorney with the FTC's Bureau of Consumer Protection, Enforcement Division, where she investigates and prosecutes deceptive advertising and unfair trade practices cases. She also is a member of the Commission's Class Action Fairness Project team, having authored the Commission's amicus briefs objecting to the class action settlements in *Haese v. H&R Block* and *Schneider v. Citicorp Mortgage*. While in private practice, Ms. Bak represented both plaintiffs and defendants in class action antitrust and securities cases and other complex commercial litigation. She later managed professional liability litigation while at the FDIC during the banking crisis. Just prior to joining the FTC, Ms. Bak served as managing attorney and corporate secretary of the \$2.3 billion Manville Personal Injury Class Action Settlement Trust and its claims settlement facility, the Claims Resolution Management Corporation, where she managed a 10 person legal department and served on the Trust's senior management team. She received both her B.A. and J.D. degrees from Northwestern University.
