Simon Pritchard is Director of Mergers at the United Kingdom's Office of Fair Trading. The Director of Mergers plays a key role in UK merger enforcement and in formulating UK views on EC merger control issues.

Mr. Pritchard previously served for two years as Deputy Director in the OFT's Mergers Branch. His responsibilities included review of the bids by Deutsche Börse and Euronext for the London Stock Exchange and the UK's input into the EC Horizontal Merger Guidelines.

In the private sector, Mr. Pritchard has represented clients in complex U.S. and EC merger and antitrust matters before the European Commission, the Federal Trade Commission, and the Antitrust Division of the Department of Justice. He was a resident associate in the Washington D.C. office of Cleary, Gottlieb, Steen & Hamilton LLP from 2001-2003. In Brussels, he was associated with Freshfields Bruckhaus Deringer LLP from 1999-2000.

Mr. Pritchard is a member of the New York Bar. He holds law and political science degrees from the University of Adelaide, Australia, and a masters in law from the University of Heidelberg, Germany. He speaks German and Dutch.
