

Policy of the
Board of Governors
of the
Tennessee Bar Association
Concerning Editorial Control of *Tennessee Bar Journal*

The Board of Governors hereby delegates to the Editorial Board of the *Tennessee Bar Journal* editorial control of the *Journal*, subject to the following policies:

1. The content of the *Journal*, including editorial and advertising content, is the responsibility of the Editorial Board of the *Journal*, with the regular advice of the staff.
2. The executive Director supervises the staff of the association. As a part of these duties, the Executive Director also supervises the Editor of the *Journal* and other staff in the administration, production, printing, and distribution of the *Journal*.
3. The editorial Board, under the leadership of its Chair, may use any reasonable formal or informal procedures as it sees fit to exercise this responsibility.
4. If, as to any decision of the Editorial Board concerning the publication or failure to publish, the Executive Director believes that the decision is not in the best interest of the Association, the Executive Director may, with full notice to the Chair of the Editorial Board, bring the matter directly to the attention of the President.
5. The President, after consultation with the Executive Director and the Chair of the Editorial Board, may change the decision of the Editorial Board, and the decision of the President will be final. The President may, in his or her discretion, bring the matter to the attention of the Executive Committee or the Board of Governors for consultation or decision.
