

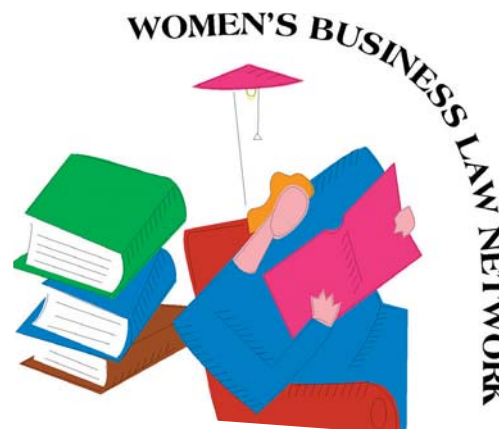
# Women in the Law: Past, Present and Future
