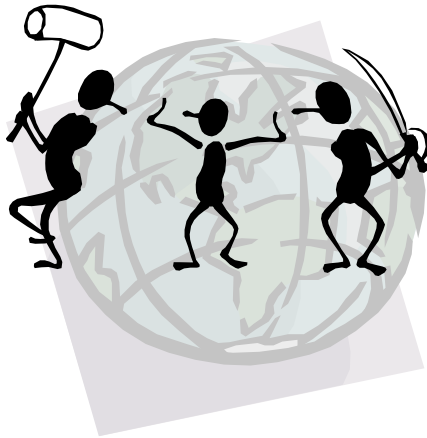

The World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), the American Bar Association (ABA) Section of Intellectual Property Law, and AIPPI US, in cooperation with the ABA Section of Dispute Resolution, are offering a special co-sponsored program on Mediation and Arbitration of Intellectual Property Disputes. The program will be held at the Newberry Library in Chicago, November 3, 2006.

During the morning session, this year's AIPPI U.S. Annual Meeting will present the outcome of the Working Questions at the AIPPI 40th World Intellectual Property Congress in Gothenburg, Sweden, and kick-off the U.S. Group's work on the new Working Questions for the 2007 Singapore Meeting and Forum and preparations for the 2008 AIPPI World Congress in Boston, the first to be held in the United States in over 30 years. The afternoon program will feature presentations on international ADR and domain name dispute resolution trends. The meeting will feature substantive and interesting discussions of "hot" international IP topics, and will also provide an excellent networking opportunity.
