JUDICIAL MENTOR PROGRAM

The Judicial Division has initiated the Judicial Mentor Program to achieve greater diversity in the judiciary and encourage minority lawyers to seek and achieve judicial office. The mentor program is open to all attorneys and judges regardless of ABA membership.

Attorneys and judges wishing to participate in the program will provide information to permit pairing of attorneys with judges in the area of the judiciary to which the lawyer aspires. The lawyers will have the opportunity for individualized guidance in the effort to reach their goals.
