Judge John E. Conery, District Judge for the Sixteenth Judicial District, Parishes of St. Mary, Iberia and St. Martin, was elected President of the Louisiana District Judge's Association at the organization's Annual Conference on October 6, 2008. Judge Conery was also elected Chief Judge of the 16<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court (JDC).

Judge Conery is a 1970 cum laude graduate of Loyola Law School where he also served on the Law Review and President of the Student Bar Association. Prior to his election to the Bench in 1995, Judge Conery practiced law for 25 years, most of which as a sole practitioner handling maritime personal injury, general trial work and a broad based, general practice.

Judge Conery has been serving on the Board of the District Judge's Association for several years and also serves as a Board Member of the American Judge's Association and Chair of the Domestic Violence Committee. He is co-author of the Capital Crimes Benchbook for Louisiana Judges and Chair of the Capital Crimes Education Committee. In addition to Capital Crimes, Judge Conery has been active in Judicial Education, especially the topics of professionalism, ethics, evidence and procedure, domestic violence and elder abuse. He received the Bob Jones Memorial Award for excellence in judicial education from the American Judge's Association in 2006.

The Louisiana District Judge's Association serves all elected District Judges in the State of Louisiana. The President is elected for a one (1) year term beginning October 1, 2008.

Judge Conery resides in Franklin, Louisiana, with his wife, Brooksie Breaux Conery. Together, the couple have five (5) children and seven (7) active and wonderful grandchildren.
