

Registration Information

Meeting Registration

The Midwinter Meeting registration fee is **\$525** per person for Section of Labor & Employment Law members and **\$625** for non-Section members. A discounted registration fee of **\$425** is available for "Early Bird" registration (prior to January 19, 2007). First-Time Attendees, Law Students, Government Agency and Non-Profit Employees may register for **\$275**. The registration fees cover the Wednesday Welcome Reception, Thursday Reception and Dinner and Friday Networking Reception, as well as all meeting materials, continental breakfasts and refreshment breaks during the meeting. The guest/spouse registration fee of **\$125** (**\$50** for children 12-18) includes the Wednesday, Thursday and Friday evening events.

You also may register by filling out the attached registration form and returning it with your payment by March 9 to the Section office. Registration fees are refundable, less a \$50 administrative fee, for cancellations received in the Section Office by March 9, 2007.

Hotel Accommodations

We have negotiated special group rates at The Charleston Place Hotel of **\$279** (single or double occupancy). In addition, Club Rooms are available for **\$379** per night (limited availability). The reservation deadline for the group rate is **February 20, 2007**. If necessary, cancellations must be made 24 hours prior to the scheduled day of arrival to avoid a one-night cancellation charge.
