STIPULATED ORDER FOR STAY
PURSUANT TO §590 SOLDIERS'
AND SAILORS' CIVIL RELIEF
ACT; 50 USC App. §§ 501-593

THIS MATTER came before the court after arguments upon the merits before this Court, on the stipulations of the parties, by and through their respective attorneys of record, Patricia E Apy and Kathryn Root for petitioner/mother and ----- for respondent/father. Based on those arguments, these stipulations and the record and file herein, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. Petitioner, -----, has demonstrated that she is *insert rank and general location*, The Pentagon, Washington, D.C. Petitioner has, pursuant to §521 of the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act, demonstrated that she is in military

1 service and has been on active duty at least sixty (60) days
2 preceding the date that respondent filed his Motion and Order to
3 Show Cause for Modification of Parenting Time and Child Support.

4 2. The parties have stipulated and the Court has found
5 that Petitioner's ability to defend or prosecute the underlying
6 action would be materially affected by her military service. As
7 such, a stay of all proceedings in Clackamas County Circuit Court,
8 Department of Domestic Relations, is hereby entered under Case No.
9 -----. Such stay is effective until thirty (30) days after the
10 cessation of Petitioner's/military member's period of mobilization
11 (*note while the statute provides for a longer stay, the parties*
12 *stipulated to a specific length of time*).

13 3. The parties have agreed to entry of detailed Interim
14 Orders Pursuant To 50 USC §590, which sets forth specific terms
15 necessary to facilitate the protection of the military member and
16 her dependents. A copy of said document is attached hereto as
17 Exhibit 1, and incorporated herein by reference. The parties are
18 hereby ordered to comply with its terms.
