**Amendment to G-105E of ABA Guidelines for the Approval of
Paralegal Education Programs**

At its meeting on June 9-10, 2006, the Standing Committee on Paralegals amended portions of G105E of the ABA Guidelines to read as follows:

- E. The following entities are authorized to take the above-listed actions.
1. . . .
 2. The Committee may
 - a. place a program on probation;
 - b. issue an order to show cause why approval should not be withdrawn; and
 - c. remove a program from probation or show cause status.
 3. The Approval Commission may
 - a. defer action on applications for approval;
 - b. defer action on applications for reapproval;
 - c. issue warnings; and
 - d. remove a program from warning status.
 4. The chair of the Approval Commission may
 - a. issue warnings; and
 - b. remove a program from warning status.
