

Section of Litigation Committee Periodicals Author Guidelines: *Expert Alert*

Expert Alert, published by the The Section of Litigation's Expert Witnesses committee, covers substantive matters of interest to lawyers whose litigation work involves the use of expert witnesses.

Style. Use a style that is more of a magazine style than what would be found in a law journal article. Review a sample copy of the periodical to get a feel for its style by looking at the previous issues on this website.

Manuscript Preparation. Submit manuscript via email attachment to the editor in Word format, if possible.

Form. Transition from topic to topic using subheadings. Do not use outline form.

Endnotes. Citations should appear as endnotes and follow the Harvard Bluebook 17th edition style. The notes should be limited to accurate citations. In general, it is best to *minimize the number of citations*. In particular, we discourage "*Id.*" citations. Where possible, avoid long endnotes and include commentary within the body text of articles.

Length. Feature article manuscripts typically are **between 2,000 and 3,500 words long**, including endnotes.

Biographical note. Under your title and name, include a short sentence (about 25 words) describing your current professional affiliation. This bio will appear with your article if it is accepted for publication.

Editing. If your article is accepted for publication, it will undergo peer review in addition to editing by ABA Publishing. Editors will send the author a pre-page proof draft for review, but because of deadline pressures, authors do not see typeset proofs. The editorial staff reserves the right to make deletions to conform to space limitations.

Copyright. The ABA retains the copyright to all material published in Section of Litigation Committee Periodicals. Authors are asked to sign a copyright agreement that grants to the ABA the exclusive right of first publication, the nonexclusive right to reprint, and the right to use the work in another ABA publication or medium.
