IMPORTANT: Annual Meeting Registration and Check-in Process

Upon arrival to Chicago for the ABA Annual Meeting in July, law students must first visit the ABA **MAIN Registration Desk** at the Chicago Hyatt Hotel and Towers to obtain their official Annual Meeting badge and materials. Here you will receive your "**all access badge to CLE programs**" and your credentials to sign-in with the Law Student Division as an official law student attendee. Once you have obtained your meeting materials and "*Law Student Annual Meeting attendee badge*" from the main ABA Registration Desk at the Hyatt Hotel, you should proceed to the Marriott Hotel to obtain your Law Student Division Annual Meeting materials and any necessary voting credentials (required for SBA Presidents and ABA Representatives who will serve as delegates during the Division's elections and Assembly). Law students who have not visited the main ABA registration desk at the Hyatt Hotel and obtained their official ABA Annual Meeting badge will not be permitted to check-in with the Law Student Division at the Marriott Hotel or permitted to attend any Annual Meeting events, including those sponsored by the Law Student Division.
