- Elected by SBA Presidents and ABA Representatives at Annual Meeting
- Represent the Law Student Division in the ABA House of Delegates (ABA policy-making body)

Student Directors (National)

Work with the Division's National Competitions and Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA)

Liaisons (National)

Represent the Division to an appointed ABA Section, Division or Forum and serve as the conduit of information between the two.
