

Sandeep Gopalan

Prof. Gopalan's research and teaching are primarily in the areas of transnational commercial law and corporate governance law. Before commencing his teaching career at ASU, Prof. Gopalan was a Rhodes Scholar at Oxford where he did doctoral research on the harmonisation of national commercial laws, after finishing his B.C.L. degree. Prior to that he graduated from the National Law School of India with a Gold Medal in constitutional law. Prof. Gopalan's career has included stints on Wall Street and in London as an investment banker and in California as a lawyer. In addition to several scholarly articles, Prof. Gopalan is also the author of a book entitled "Transnational Commercial Law." He is a member of the California bar. In 2005, Prof. Gopalan was appointed to the Arizona Aerospace and Defense Commission by Gov. Janet Napolitano. He is currently the chairman of that commission. He is also vice-chair of the ABA committee on international secured transactions and insolvency law.
