

BOARD OF IMMIGRATION APPEALS (BIA) ACCREDITATION PUBLICATION

The Commission on Immigration Policy, Practice and Pro Bono of the American Bar Association has published Board of Immigration Appeals Accreditation and Entering Immigration Appearances, a guide to gaining and maintaining Board of Immigration Appeals recognition for non-profit organizations and representative accreditation for their paralegals and legal assistant staff.

Board of Immigration Appeals Accreditation and Entering Immigration Appearances provides step-by step instructions to organizational recognition and representative accreditation, and to how both lawyers and accredited representatives may enter immigration appearances. The 100 page manual contains sample forms, examples of submissions from successful accreditation applications, insight into BIA and INS decision-making, and a copy of the accreditation regulation: 8 C.F.R. ' 292 (1993).
