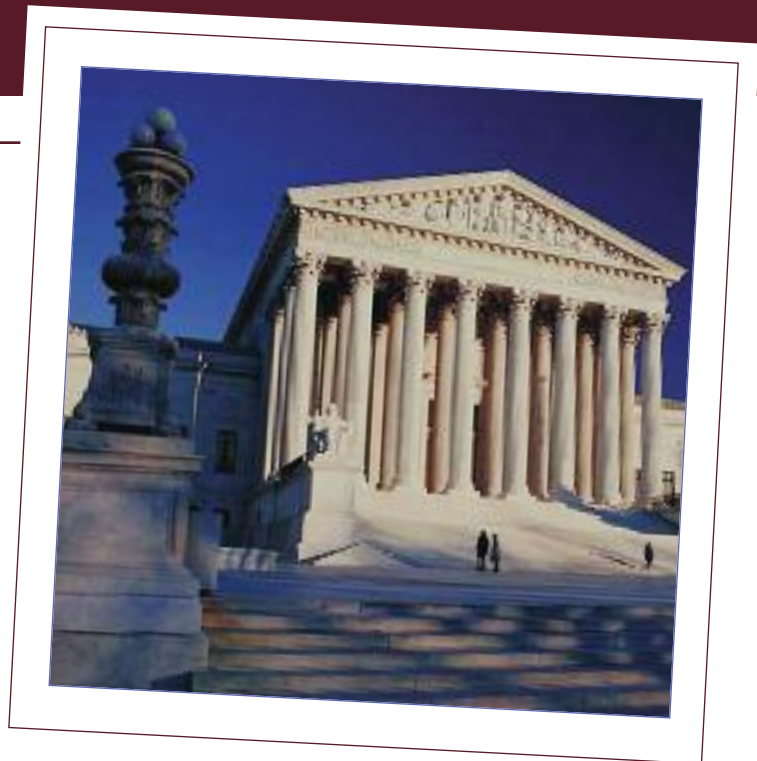
Become part of history when you take your oath before the United States Supreme Court Justices as a new admittee to the bar of the Supreme Court of the United States on June 9, 2008. Enjoy social events, including a reception at the U.S. Supreme Court after the bar admissions ceremony. Registration is open to bar admittees, and their families and friends. The non-refundable registration fee is \$700 per person.

BAR ADMISSIONS

ABA members in practice for at least three years who can travel to Washington, DC and be sworn in before the Supreme Court Justices on June 9, 2008, are invited to apply. **Bar admission is open to 50 applicants.**

- Complete and submit the bar admissions application with the signatures of two lawyers previously admitted to the Supreme Court of the United States.
- Obtain an original “Certificate of Good Standing” from the highest state court.
- Complete the Supreme Court Trip registration form.
- Pay a \$700 **nonrefundable** Supreme Court Trip registration fee for each person attending the bar admission ceremony or any social event.

Bar admission slots are exclusive and not transferable. If for any reason an admittee is unable to attend in person, bar admission will be granted at a later date by the Supreme Court.
