In 2004 the Women's Bar Association of the State of New York at its 25th anniversary gala dinner, established the Betty Weinberg Ellerin Mentoring Award, for her leadership and inspiration to the women of the legal profession. In 2006 she received the prestigious Robert B. McKay Award from the N.Y.U. School of Law "in recognition of her distinguished service and extraordinary accomplishments in the advancement of justice."
